- Participate in Coordinated Entry.
- Draw funds quarterly and expend timely.
- Submit APR, quarterly reports, and participate in on-site monitoring.
- Participate in annual Point-in-Time count.
- Comply with FY2025 NOFO requirements, including:
  - o Fair Housing, VAWA, and nondiscrimination laws.
  - o No operation of drug injection sites or facilitation of illicit drug use.
  - o Integration of behavioral health and recovery services.
  - Contribution to system performance measures.
- Do not use funds for prohibited activities (e.g., drug injection sites or illegal drug use facilitation).
- Ensure housing is ADA-compliant and promotes integration for persons with disabilities.
- Offer or coordinate access to mental health and substance use treatment services.
- Implement strategies to improve income and housing stability.
