Local Competition FAQ

Question	Answer
Will the recent court ruling affect the 2026 CoC competition timeline?	Possibly, but the CoC is moving forward with the current timeline unless HUD changes or rescinds the process.
Can applicants stop working on applications until the litigation is resolved?	No. Applicants should continue preparing applications because the current competition timeline remains in effect.
How much can a new project request?	New project applications, included DV Bonus, are capped at \$150,000 . After scoring, ranking, and HUD's release of funding amounts, the CoC Board may consider budget adjustments if additional funding is available.
If funding availability changes, can project budgets be revised later?	Potentially yes. The expectation is that adjustments could be allowed, but any change would require a board decision once funding amounts are known. 1
Why hasn't the Annual Renewal Demand (ARD) amount been released yet?	HUD has indicated that the ARD has been delayed for several reasons including 2025 renewal processing, litigation, and contracting delays. HUD has indicated the ARD should be released soon.
Is the 2026 CoC application available in eSnaps yet?	As of the meeting, July 8 th @ 2:30 PM the 2026 application was not visible in eSnaps. Applicants should continue checking for availability.
When should the application be available in eSnaps?	There is no confirmed date, but it is expected to be available before final project decisions are due on August 11, so applicants have time to complete and submit applications.
Why does the NOFO still reference a 10% de	Federal regulations generally allow eligible recipients to elect a 15% de minimis indirect cost rate. The reason the

minimis indirect cost rate instead of 15%?	CoC NOFO and/or eSnaps may still reference 10% is currently unclear. The CoC is seeking clarification from HUD on whether this is an intentional program requirement or a system/form update issue.
What should applicants do if they have questions while completing the application?	Attend future office hours or contact the CoC directly by email at anna.edwards@wycoc.org . Frequent questions will be added to the public FAQ.
Do applicants need to submit eSnaps narratives as part of the local competition application?	No. Applicants only need to submit the local competition application.
What is the deadline for the local competition application?	Local competition applications are due July 20 at 4 PM and submitted to anna.edwards@wycoc.org .
When will final project rankings be posted	The CoC must publicly post final project rankings and priority listings by August 11. Individual applicants will also review an email from the WY CoC about their rankings
When are final applications due in eSnaps?	The CoC will publicly post the final project rankings and Priority Listing by August 11. Applicants will also receive an email from the Wyoming CoC notifying them of their individual project ranking and any next steps.
